


Our club's eye and dental missions have served the areas along the Rio San Juan.

- AC. \$10,000 (assumed new).
- Generator. \$2,000.

- Shipping. \$2,000 (will depend on what is acquired here in the states.

struction Cost Estimates

- Two bids received. They do not include generators and AC.
- One builder is from San Carlos and constructed the operating rooms in San Carlos. His bid is \$103,000.
