



Santa Rosa Sunrise Rotary Student Project Grants

Purpose: To foster and encourage students to participate in programs or projects which will directly benefit them in achieving a career or life goal and assist them in making a contribution to their specific community.

The program or project may be corollary of an existing program: a specific project which requires, special equipment, supplies or tools, travel to workshops, seminars or special program which directly related to a stated objective. This is not a "general scholarship", this is a grant for a specific project.

Eligibility: Any full time student and any Sonoma County High School, continuation school, Santa Rosa Junior College, Sonoma State University, professional or vocational school.

Amount: Not to exceed \$250.00 dollars per grant. The grant amount can not represent the entire amount needed for the project or program cost. That is, the student must provide some of their own money from donations, earned money or family.

Procedure: Submit letter applications to the Sunrise Board of Directors 60 days before funding date and include:

1. A short resume, single page double spaced.
2. A short description of the project or program, how the program or equipment will benefit the students goals.
3. Amount of money needed and source of the other funds.
