COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM

Enclosed is an application for the Granger Sunrise Rotary Club Community Grant Program and criteria for eligibility. This is a special fund set aside each year to help meet the short-term needs of Not-for-Profit organizations requiring financial assistance.

A limited number of grants are available and awarded each year. The grant should not go towards general operating expenses. Recipients of the grant will be asked to return to the Granger Sunrise Rotary Club and share how the funds were utilized, and how it impacted the recipients.

Additionally, we ask you to consider if there is an opportunity for our club to participate in a service project with your organization. As a service club we value the chance to partner with community organizations by offering not just our finances but our services as well.

To apply for funds from our Community Grant Program, the attached application should be completed in its entirety. If you are a certified 501c3 organization, please include an IRS determination letter stating your organization's certification of Not-for-Profit status along with a statement of your financial condition.
