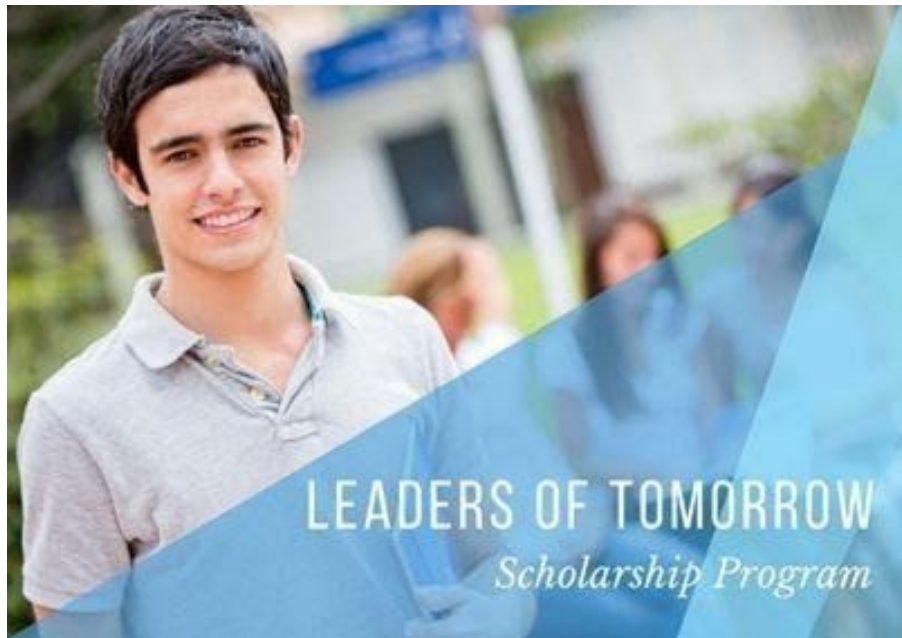


ROTARY LEADERS OF TOMORROW SCHOLARSHIP

2. A proven track record of contributing to the community, clear career aspirations, and demonstrable and/or developing leadership qualities.

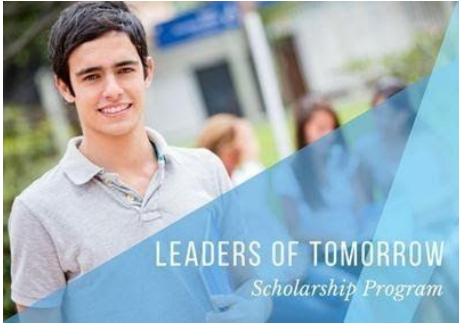
ESSAY QUESTIONS

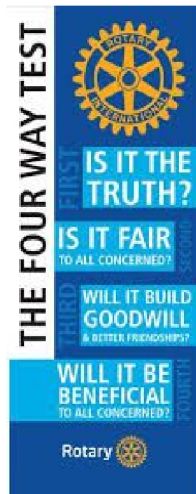
