

Associate Member Guidelines

- **First time prospective Rotary members have the option to apply to become an Associate Member.**
- **A prospect must be sponsored by a current regular member and attend at least 2 meetings before submitting an application.**
- **An application is required to be completed and submitted to the club secretary.**
- **Dues are currently \$50 for 6 months and may be renewed for an additional 6 month term. Dues will be billed beginning with the next billing cycle after approval.**
- **After one year as an Associate a decision is required to convert to a Regular Member at the then current dues rate.**
- **Lunch is paid for at the door. \$10 currently.**
- **A Rotary orientation is required and the applicant will be contacted by the Orientation committee for arrangements.**
- **Following approval by the Board of Directors, the associate member will be:**
 - **Introduced to the club, presented a badge, and give a brief personal history.**
 - **Encouraged to participate in club meetings and all club activities.**
 - **Expected to participate in at least one service project and/or to serve on one or more committees.**
 - **Required to attend at least 50% of regular meetings.**

An Associate Member must convert to full membership in order to hold a club office.
