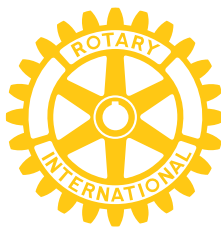


Rotary Club of Monticello



Proposal for Membership

Individuals must be sponsored or proposed for membership into a club. Often, a person being considered for membership is invited by a club member, or sponsor, to attend one or more club meetings to learn more about Rotary. In this case, the sponsor submits the candidate's name to the club's membership committee.

Please note that membership in a Rotary club is by invitation only.

Prospective member must:

- Hold (or be retired from) a professional, proprietary, executive, managerial, or community position
- Have demonstrated a commitment to service through personal involvement
- Be able to meet club's weekly attendance or community project participation requirements
- Live or work within the vicinity of the club or surrounding area

New member process:

- Complete this form; include no initiation and other fees; they will be billed upon acceptance by the Club.
- Proposal will be reviewed by Membership Committee and Board of Directors
- Prospective member's name and information is circulated to all members of the Club for 2 weeks
- If there are no objections, nominee is welcomed into the Club
