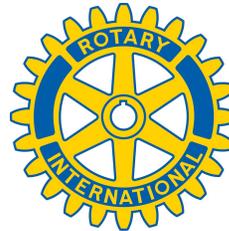

4. Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

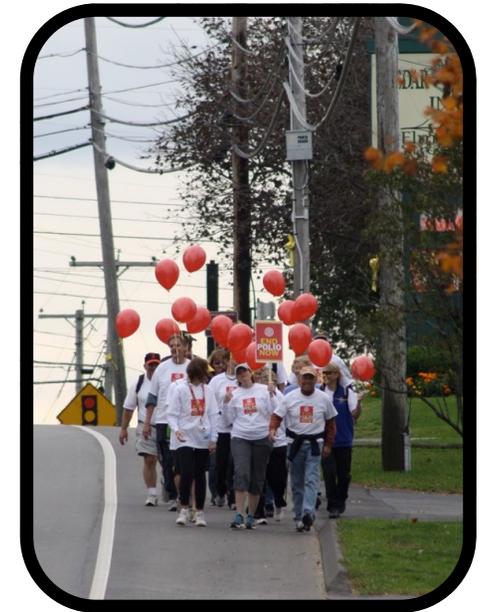
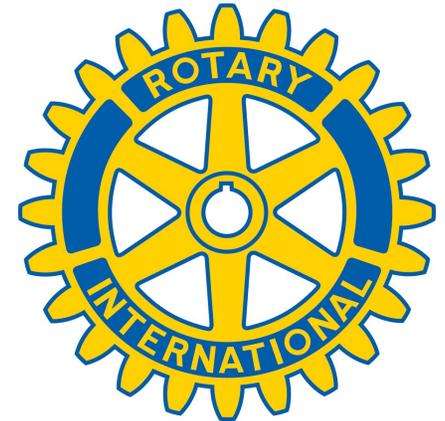
