- 3. Finalist will be selected and interviews will be conducted by members of Santa Clara Rotary Club in late April.
- 4. Scholarship honorees and placement counselors will be notified by mail early May, 2020. Scholarship recipients will receive a \$4,000 scholarship (\$2,000 a year for two years each).
- 5. Recipients who successfully complete the first two years of community college or

trade school may be eligible to receive an additional \$4000 scholarship (\$2,000 a year for two years each) to continue his or her education at a 4-year university.
