ROTARY CLUB OF JOLIET MEETING MAKE-UP POLICY 1/2010

Whereas the Rotary Club of Joliet recognizes the need for active, committed members; and

Whereas the Rotary Club of Joliet recognizes that participation in club-sanctioned activities can encourage a club member to be as much, or more committed to Rotary than attendance at regular weekly meetings;

Now, Therefore, The Rotary Club of Joliet hereby adopts this Meeting Make-up Policy.

- 1. Make-ups may be credited for only two weeks preceding or following absence from a regular weekly meeting of the Joliet Rotary Club and may not comprise more than 25% of the member's total attendance in a Rotary year.
- 2. Make-up may be obtained in any of the following manners:
 - 2.1 Attend the regular weekly meeting of another Rotary Club.
 - 2.2 Attend a Rotary District 6450 program or committee meeting.
 - 2.3 Attend a Rotary International program or committee meeting.
 - 2.4 Represent the Joliet Rotary Club at an event sponsored by another Rotary Club, a Rotary District, or Rotary International.
 - 2.5 Participate in a Club-sponsored social event.
 - 2.6 Participate in a Club-sponsored service project. To qualify for make-up credit, the participant must:
 - a) Have been recruited through the Wheel; via electronic notice or from the podium at a weekly meeting; and
 - b) Be with other Rotarians during the activity; and
 - c) Represent Rotary during the activity.
 - 2.7 Attend a Club Board or committee meeting. To qualify for make-up, the meeting must:
 - a) Have been announced to the general Club membership through the Wheel; via electronic notice or at a weekly meeting; and
 - b) May not be held immediately before, during, immediately after, or in conjunction with participation in a regular weekly meeting or any other allowed make-ups as described above.

This policy is hereby adopted this 14th day of January, 2010, by a vote of 8 yea to 0 nay.
