



ROTARY INTERNATIONAL SERVICE PROJECT  
**2023 UGANDA SERVICE PROJECT**  
February 10, 2023 – February 23, 2023

The trip is being coordinated by the Rotary Club of Chicago Citywide Service in partnership with the Rotaract Club of Kampala South. The Rotaract Club of Kampala South adopted the community of Nyakijumba in the year 2016 after conducting a needs assessment. This project will be located at the **Nyakijumba Primary School** in Kabale. Kabale is located in southwest Uganda. The trip is open to Rotarians from District 6450 and 6440 and their guest, based on available space.

The project will consist of several components. The Rotaract Club of Kampala South has been instrumental in the construction of a new building at the school. That project is currently approximately 55% completed and this project will focus on working towards the completion of the building (flooring, painting, install of windows and doors and plastering). Additionally, there will be a team of members who will be involved in educational tasks with the students at the school.

The service project component of this trip runs from February 10 to the morning of February 18. After the work week has ended, on Saturday February 18, 2023 team members will depart for their selected excursion.
