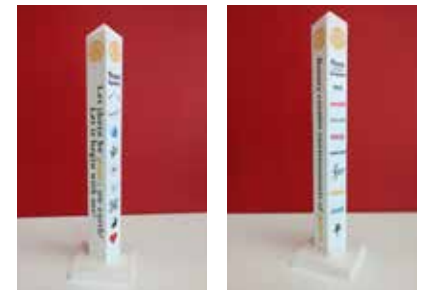

## PEACE POLES

A Peace Pole is an internationally-recognized symbol of the hopes and dreams of the entire human family, standing vigil in silent prayer for peace on earth. Peace poles are now the most recognized monument dedicated to peace on earth. They represent the highest aspirations of peace and goodwill inherent in the human heart, transcending race, religion, and creed.

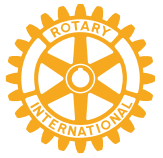
The Peace Pole originated in Japan in 1955 through the efforts of Masahisa Goi who, moved by the tragedy of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, dedicated his life to spreading the message of peace.

There are now over 200,000 peace poles standing in almost every country throughout the world. They serve as constant reminders for us to visualize, pray and work for world peace.

Peace poles generally bear messages of peace on four to six sides along with symbols and words of peace in various languages.

Individuals and organizations such as Rotary Clubs, schools, and businesses are invited to plant peace poles at locations of high visibility. This gesture sends a signal of commitment to peace and the intention to work to accomplish peace on earth.

It is appropriate to dedicate your peace pole in a ceremony that can commemorate a special occasion.
