**(Applicant may keep this page for your records)**

**Note 1: Classification**

The classification of each active member is that which describes the principal and recognized activity of the firm or institution with which the member is connected or that which describes the member's principal and recognized business or professional activity. Rotary International is a vocation-based organization, and tries to maintain some consistency in its classification of members. The Club's President may suggest a different classification from that suggested by the applicant, but will discuss it with the applicant if necessary.

**Note 2: Community service**

**Note 3: Attendance**

Regular meetings of the Club are held once a week at such a time as the board decides (currently, each Tuesday from 12.00 pm to 1.10 pm at the Ottawa University Union). The lunch fee will be billed at cost for those meetings you attend. Members are expected to attend at least 60% of regular club meetings in the year, but can make-up not more than half of those meetings by attending the regular meetings of other clubs anywhere in the world, attending committee or board meetings, participating in service activities or on-line make-ups.

**Note 5: Fees**
