

2010 Parade of Heroes

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- 1. The safety of our parade participants and viewers is critical! If there is a problem with your entry, it WILL HAVE to be corrected before being allowed in the parade. The Rotary Parade Committee reserves the absolute right to reject any parade entrant from participation in the Parade of Heroes.
- 2. Consumption of alcohol or use of illegal narcotics will not be permitted by anyone participating with your entry in the staging area or throughout the entire parade route.
- 3. Distribution of candy and/or other things along the route will be allowed PROVIDED a WALKING member of the group distributes it. It must NOT BE THROWN to the crowd! This is a preventative measure to assure that no child will run toward a moving or stationary vehicle or get out in the street. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 4. NO FIREWORKS during the parade and in the staging areas.
- 5. NO STOPPING on the parade route will be permitted unless instructed to do so by a police officer or Parade Official. No getting on and off any float while the parade is in progress.
- 6. Vehicles will be moving very slowly with lots of stops and starts. Keep your radiator free of banners to give maximum airflow. Large trucks, large trailers, and ANY vehicle with reduced movement or vision SHOULD have an adult walking along on all sides. Small children MUST NOT be allowed on the edge of any vehicle. If someone is standing, support should be given.
- 7. NO HORSES are allowed in the Parade of Heroes.
- 8. Walking entries should be aware that the parade is approximately .6 miles long, plus up to .8 miles from the last staging area.
- 9. Bicycles all bicycle riders are REQUIRED to wear an appropriate safety helmet while riding in the parade.
- 10. Weather The parade goes on rain or shine. There is NO rain date. If there are heavy storms in the area, there could be a delay in the start time. Safety of all is of prime importance!

We will be staging all entrants facing southwest, along France Family Drive. Please pay close attention to Parade Personnel who will be directing you to the correct staging area.

Violation of any of these rules will result in your removal from the Parade of Heroes.
