## Billing/Cost Information for Rotarians

Annual Rotary International Dues of \$200/year along with \$112/year for local dues are billed in quarterly payments on January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1 of each year. **Dues are not refundable.** 

Meals are charged at \$14.00 per meeting paid in advance and billed quarterly. Typically, there are 12 to 13 meetings in a quarter which will result in a quarterly billing of \$168 or \$182. There is no refund on meetings missed or should you resign from the club prior to the end of the quarter. However, you may send someone in your place if you are unable to attend a meeting. There is no provision for Rotarians to go inactive and not pay for their meals. If you bring a guest, you will be billed the \$14.00 meal fee on your next billing statement.

All dues and meals fees will be billed each quarter and expected to be paid promptly so that we can maximize our charitable works in the community. **The only way to avoid paying dues and meal fees is to resign from the club.** If you decide to resign all resignations must be sent to the current Denison Rotary President requesting to resign from the club.

New members will be billed on a prorated basis for their meals and dues when they join the club until the end of that quarter for meals or until the end of that quarterly billing cycle for dues.

The total approximate cost to be a Denison Rotarian is about \$1000/year.
