

During her 12-month reign, she will make more than 250 appearances and speak before over 100K people about Texas Cares for Children Program, The Children's Miracle Network, and her personal platform, *The Leader Within*. Chandler is a flautist and plays other instruments. And she attended the same high school as **Beyonce!**
