
of only are we losing LENNY as President, but we're losing **Kent Stone** as District Governor's Liaison. He promises that he's not yet dead, so he'll make up


That was in keeping with LENNY'S theme of what an accomplished group we are. HE cited the Bucket Buck\$ that went to Plano Children's Medical Clinic, OPERATION ONCE IN A LIFETIME, Wheelchairs, Habitat for Humanity, West, Cleburne, and Granbury Disaster Relief. HE told us of the \$73K we'd raised for Hendrick Scholarships and the funds given to Frisco Rotary for its Honduran Water Project. The Soap Box Derby had netted \$19K, and from all our contributions at the recent District Gala, \$50K is being donated to the Rotary International Foundation.

All in all, during HIS year as President, *Plano Rotary* had raised almost \$200,000 (\$1,739 a head) for charities. But, HE said, it's "not just the money." To demonstrate, HE

mentioned the monthly socials, student mentoring, Citizen of the Month, and the bicycle donation to *Memorial Elementary* children.

And who could forget the inventor of the LED playing harmonica with his nose?

We've grown to 115 members not including our newly-added corporate members. We've had political forums





We help run the City and the school district. LENNY paused to gain self-control, and then HE continued, we include "the fire chief, the Collin College President, and every aspect of commerce." And not merely those but also Rotarians who are "special because we serve."
