David Whorter introduced our speaker for this week, Pat Reeder



Pat Reeder has worked in both corporate communications and entertainment for nearly three decades. He has written for clients ranging from Sylanvia and Southwestern Bell to Tony Randall to Barney the Dinosaur. He's been a major market radio DJ and production director for

stations such as KLUV here in Dallas. Many people don't realize that radio shows have writers just like TV shows. Pat was the head writer for the syndicated Morning Punch service when it was named by trade a papers as the best written service in the radio industry. He and his wife and writing partner Laura Ainsworth then launched their own service, "The Comedy Wire."

Then-Arkansas Governor Mike Huckabee saw that at a radio station and became a fan. When he ran for President, he would sometimes use Pat's political one-liners in presidential debates. When he was asked to do his own radio show, he told ABC that he'd do it only if Pat and Laura would write it for him. SO now, Pat works every day with Governor Huckabee to write" The Huckabee Report," the most popular short syndicated feature in radio, heard three times daily on about 600 stations nationwide. He's also the



author of two books, "Hollywood Hi-Fi" and one he'll be speaking

about today that Governor Huckabee wrote the foreword for. It's called "Nine Hallmarks of Highly Incompetent Losers."

These Nine Hallmarks are as follows:

- 1. Never Plan Ahead
- 2. Lose Sight of Your Goal
- 3. Do not Sweat the Details
- 4. Do not Communicate Clearly

- 5. Work while Drunk, High or Other Addictions
- 6. Call Undue Attention to Yourself
- 7. Lose Your Cool
- 8. Claim Talents you do not Have
- 9. Bend Over Too Far Backwards




