Comprehending Comprehensively

Sainted Editor ran the numbers: (a) 5% of Texans infected with Covid and (b) an N95 mask is good for 24 hours of protection in a room with one infected person. That means that in a room containing 15 people, the chances that NONE of them are infected is $(0.95)^{15} = 0.46$ or rather a **56%** chance that (at least) one of them is infected. Better than even. “Good for 24 hours” means a 50% chance you don’t get infected **IF YOU WEAR AN N95 MASK CONTINUOUSLY**. So what are the chances you’ll survive (wearing the mask) for only an hour?

$\exp([1/24]\ln[0.5]) = 97\%$
which sounds *really* good until you realize **YOU CAN’T TAKE THE MASK OFF**, so no eating. What about a month worth of meetings? That’s $(0.97)^4 = 89\%$ which is still *sort of* good until you realize that it means that 11% of the 15 of us **WILL** catch the virus from someone in the group even if they’re masked. So do you wish the virus on 1.67 members. 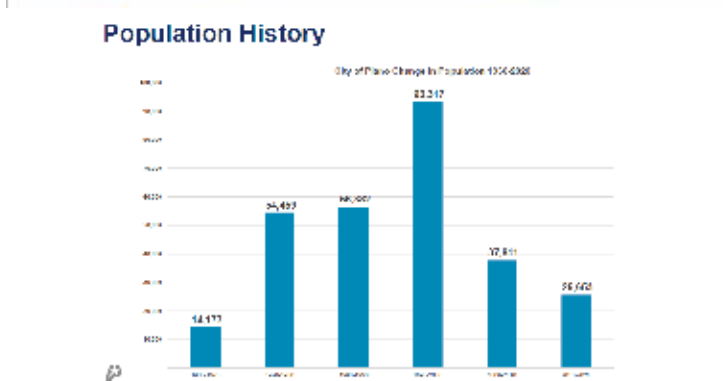

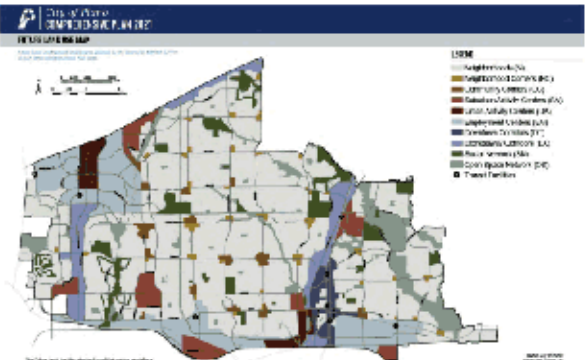

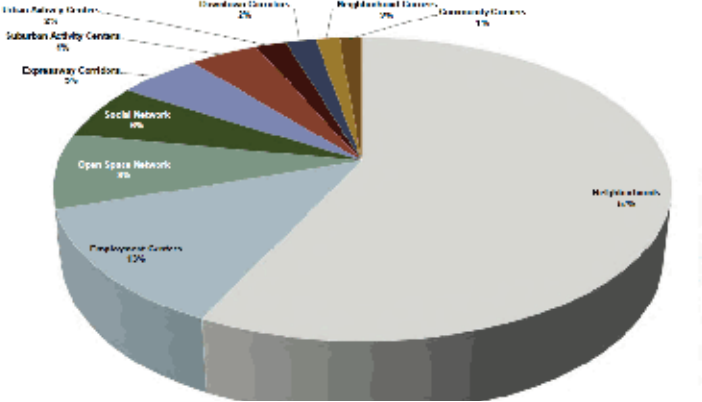

Future Land Use Map & Dashboard

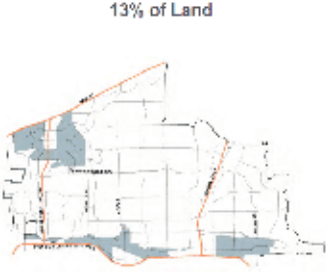


Future Land Use Category Distribution
