The drive is supported by Richardson Rotary, Richardson East Rotary, Richardson Chamber of Commerce, and – new this time – we welcome Richardson YMCA.

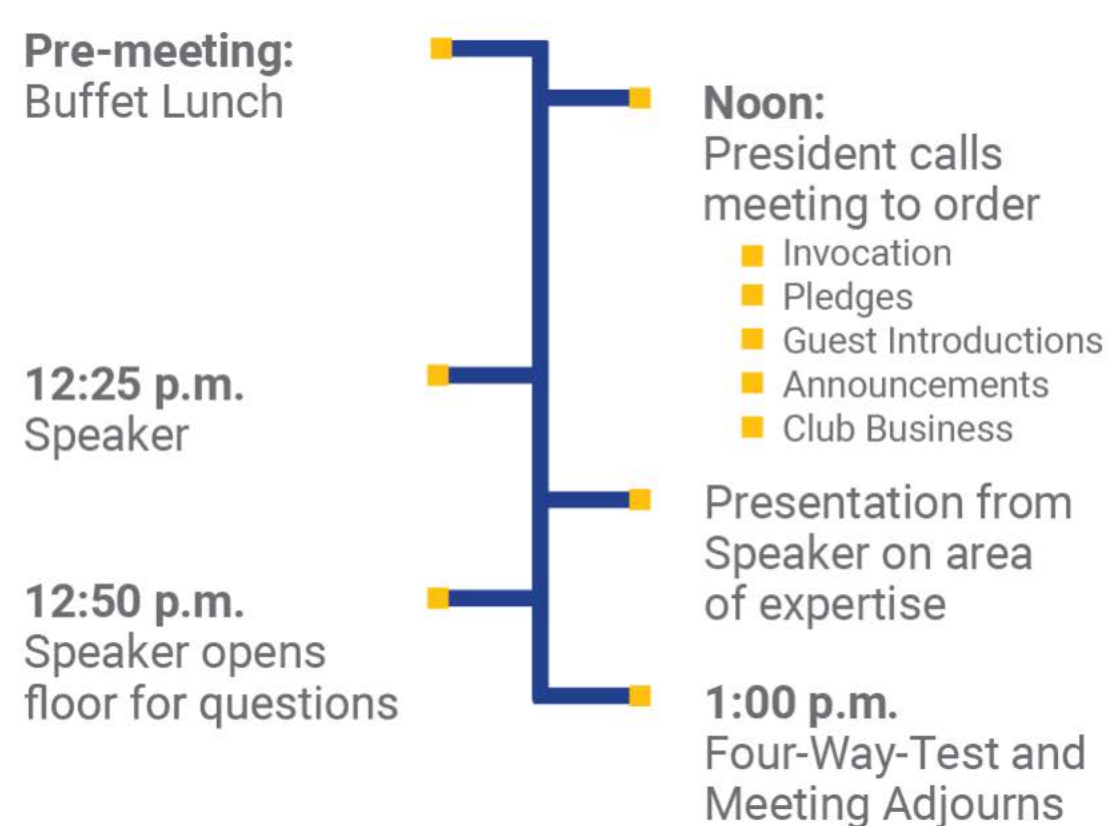

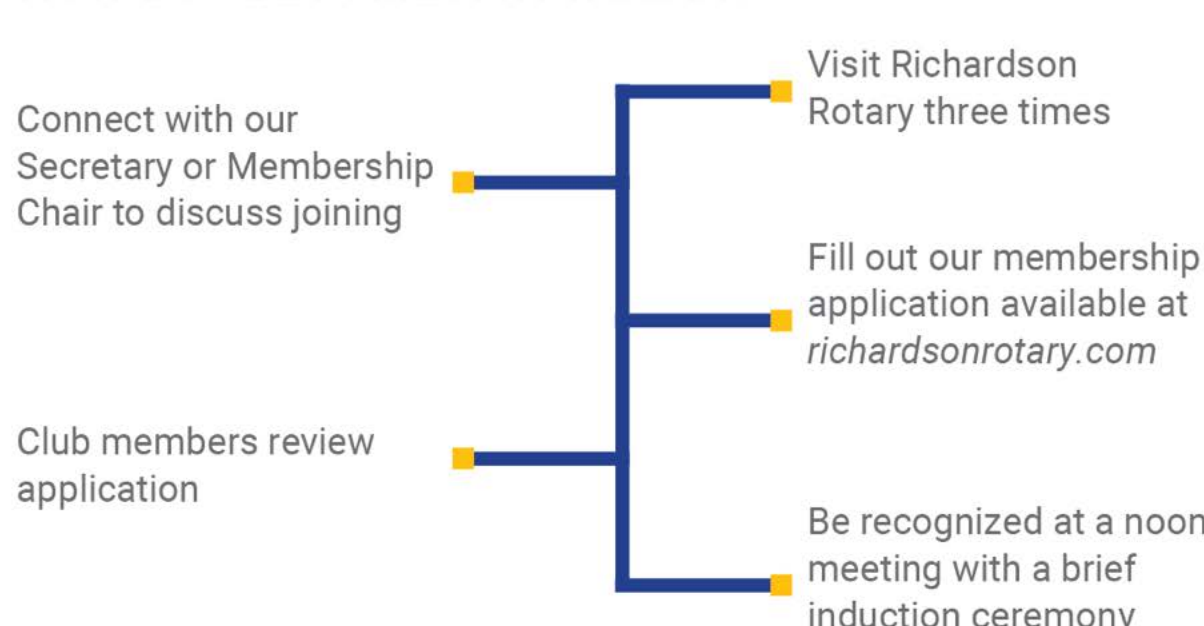
