Don Magner started with the City of Richardson in 1996 as a compensation analyst in the HR Department and has progressed through the ranks to now serve as Deputy City Manager. During his time, he has been instrumental in designing and launching the City's Home Improvement Incentive Program, creating and implementing the City's Neighborhood Vitality and Integrity Strategy, and today leads many of the economic development initiatives of the community.

Magner earned a Master of Arts in Political Science from the University of Texas at Arlington and a Bachelor of Arts in Government and Politics from the University of Texas at Dallas.

Magner is very involved in the community, with past recognition as the Richardson YMCA's volunteer of the year and has received the Network of Community Ministries' Outstanding Service Award. He is also a graduate of Leadership Richardson Class XX, the Richardson Citizens Police Academy, the Richardson Citizens Fire Academy and Leadership North Texas Class 10.
