- Worked at the Dallas Zoo since 2007 in senior leadership positions (COO, VP of Guest Experiences, Deputy Director of Education, Director of Corporate Sponsorships and Public Relations).

- Started Zoo career in 1991 at the Columbus Zoo in Ohio working with Director Emeritus Jack Hanna and the Columbus Zoo's education team.
- Entering his thirtieth year in a career working for accredited zoological parks, including the Fort Worth Zoo and as the Executive Director at the Mill Mountain Zoo in Virginia.
- Involved in the Dallas Zoo's privatization process with the City of Dallas in 2009. This partnership with the City of Dallas and Dallas Zoo Management has taken attendance from 650,000 annually to over 1.2 million in the last 10 years.
- Passionate about animals, conservation and how our Zoo guests and the community can make a difference for wildlife.
- Led four wildlife safaris to Africa in the last 15 years including trips to hike with critically endangered mountain gorillas in Rwanda, viewing the great migration of animals in Serengeti National Park, and most recently to Zambia to view Victoria Falls and the wildlife of the Zambezi River.
- The Dallas Zoo's vision is to Create a Better World for Animals and our mission is Engaging People and Saving Wildlife
