

## Makeups for Rotary Meetings Missed

Members are encouraged to make up meetings that they miss, because it counts for attendance. In addition, members often experience Rotary in other ways, helping them to remain engaged in Rotary International.

You must make up a meeting within two weeks before or after the meeting missed.

To receive credit for a makeup, you need to make sure that you notify our club Secretary, Matt Eichman, by email: [matthew.j.eichman@gmail.com](mailto:matthew.j.eichman@gmail.com) . For each meeting that you make up, you will receive a credit for our weekly meal fee, which will be applied to your quarterly bill. If you have any questions, please consult with Matt Eichman.

### Options for Makeups

1. Attend another Rotary Meeting. This can be one of the other two clubs in Lawrence, or a Rotary Meeting anywhere in the world, and generally the secretary of the club you attend will provide you with a certification of your attendance. You should then provide this to our club Secretary, to receive credit for the makeup.
2. Attend a board meeting or committee meeting for our club. When doing this, make sure to sign the attendance sheet noting that you are requesting a makeup for a given meeting date.
3. Participate in a club service project, such as habitat or ringing bells for the Salvation Army. Ask the coordinator of the meeting to notify Matt of your participation.
4. Attend an E-club meeting. There are many E-clubs in Rotary, many of which will provide you with the opportunity to makeup a missed meeting. One of the most common E-Clubs is <https://www.rotaryeclubone.org/> A meeting is made up by spending 30 minutes on their website viewing or reading about Rotary topics.
