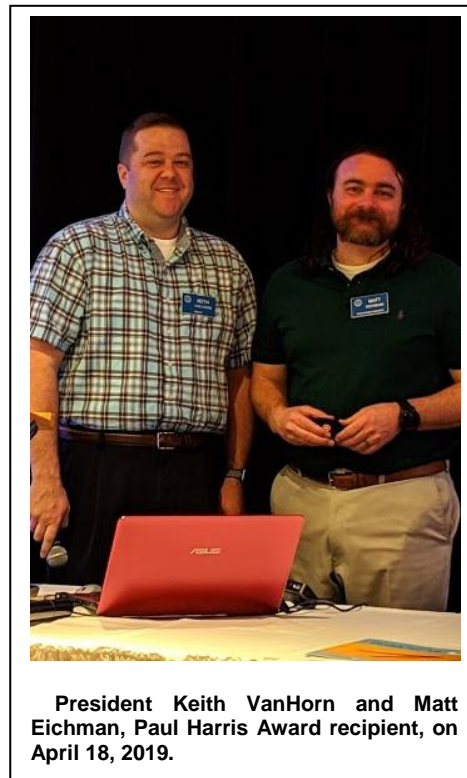

JAYHAWK ROTARIANS ACTIVELY SUPPORT PAUL HARRIS FOUNDATION

Each year Jayhawk Breakfast Rotary Club members contribute to the Paul Harris Foundation. The Foundation was created to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty.

Jayhawk Rotarians can contribute \$25 each quarter towards the Foundation. When a member's contribution amounts to \$1,000, a Paul Harris Fellow pin is awarded. Each additional \$1,000 adds a sapphire stone to the pin.

When a Rotarian pledges \$1,000 each year, she becomes a Society member. A Benefactor designates \$1,000 in the Endowment Fund or makes a provision in his estate plan.

When each accumulative donation reaches \$10,000, a Major Donor receives a crystal recognition piece and a Major Donor lapel pin or pendant. A Bequest Society Member has made a commitment of \$10,000 in her estate

plan.

Seventy-seven Rotarians from our club have made a donation to the Rotary Foundation. Currently Jayhawk Rotary Foundation contributors include:
