A little more than twenty one years ago, several visionary members of this Summit County Rotary Club launched what is now named the "Summit County Rotary Charitable Fund". Since that time, the operations and investments of the Fund have been guided by an eight person Board of Trustees, and its assets have continued to grow through regular quarterly contributions by the Club's members, annual contributions of about 10% of the net proceeds of our fundraising events, special gifts by members and other supporters, and strong investment returns. Contributors are recognized through the "Scale the Summit" program. Along the way, several years ago, we set a goal to reach \$1 million in the endowment by 2014, at a time when the assets were less than half that amount. **Last week that \$1 million goal was attained!!** During our breakfast meeting on Tuesday, March 4, we will be celebrating this major milestone and recognizing those who have made it possible.

We truly appreciate all that is being done by so many of our current members, and we encourage all members to do what they can to help this Club continue its extraordinary service. At this time, we need a co chair for the **Car Raffle** (see Joel or Stephanie) and a committee lead for the **Ice Princess** contest (see Diane). I'm sure we have members who are capable of doing a good job in those roles, while enjoying the fellowship and satisfaction that comes along - please step up NOW and help us succeed !
