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**Rotary Golf***by Wagner, Lou*

This is the protocol for Rotary golf this year.

We have early morning T times at Copper Mountain on Thursdays starting June 7th thru Sept 27 weather permitting. For Thursday, June 7th we have 5 times, 8:10 thru 8:50. If you get a T time that requires you to break the ice off the sign by #1, tough. This is mountain golf. The exact number depends on how many of you sign up. I will send out the notice on the weekend and you have until Tuesday at Noon to get back to me if you are playing. You do NOT have to tell me if you are NOT playing. We don't care if you are NOT playing. Just e-mail me back if you ARE playing. I will then assign T-times based on your preferences (early, late) or who you do (or do not) want to play with and the tips I get. This will come out as an e-mail by Tuesday evening (or earlier). After you get a T-time assigned, you are responsible to communicate with Copper and me if your spouse passes away. That is really the only excuse that will be allowed without some form of Corporal punishment being administered (Google Catholic Grade Schools in the 50's). You can sign up for 9 or 18 holes. We will try to pair up the 9 hole players so Copper has some flexibility in scheduling when we make the turn.

You need to check in at the Pro Shop. Also in order to not give me (or Art or Roy) heart palpitations it would be cool if you showed up at least 10 minutes before your T time.

Rotary Rules apply: #1 rule is keep up with the 4 some ahead of you. #2 See #1 rule. #3. HTH. Hit till happy (as long as you keep up with the bunch in front of you. #4. You will not be allowed to T-off without purchasing same from the starter or show proof of purchase from the web site.
