Historic moments Rotary mottoes Rotary's official mottoes, Service Above Self and They Profit Most Who Serve Best, trace back to the early days organization. In 1911, He Profits Most Who Serves Best was approved as the Rotary motto at the second conver the National Association of Rotary Clubs of America, in Portland, Oregon. It was adapted from a speech made b Rotarian Arthur Frederick Sheldon to the first convention, held in Chicago the previous year. Sheldon declared ti the science of right conduct toward others pays. Business is the science of human services. He profits most who his fellows best." The Portland convention also inspired the motto Service Above Self. During a convention outing Columbia River, Ben Collins, president of the Rotary Club of Minneapolis, Minnesota, USA, talked with Seattle R J.E. Pinkham about the proper way to organize a Rotary club, offering the principle his club had adopted. Service Self. Pinkham invited Paul P. Harris, who also was on the boat trip, to join their conversation. Harris asked Collin address the convention, and the phrase Service, Not Self was met with great enthusiasm. At the 1950 RI Conver Detroit, slightly modified versions of the two slogans were formally approved as the official mot toes of Rotary. He Most Who Serves Best and Service Above Self. The 1988 Council on Legislation established Service. Howe Self principal motto of Rotary, because it best conveys the philosophy of unselfish volunteer service. He Profits Most Serves Best was modified by the 2004 Council to its current wording. They Profit Most Who Serve Best.
