

District 5170 ROTARY YOUTH LEADERSHIP AWARDS

Sunday June 23rd to Friday June 28th, 2024

Each year, thousands of young people take part in the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) program worldwide. Returning high school students from around the Bay Area are selected to attend RYLA for leadership demonstrated at school or in the community. These students receive a scholarship to attend a week-long leadership camp where they learn skills about how to become better leaders, build better friendships, and how to actively apply what they have learned at camp to their lives, schools, and communities.

As a part of our commitment to serving youth, the Rotary Club of Alameda will be sponsoring four local high school students (\$950 per attendee) for the 2024 District 5170 RYLA camp (<u>https://www.ryla5170.com/</u>). Selected applicants will attend an all-expense-paid leadership conference with other outstanding high school students throughout the Bay Area. The conference will be held from Sunday June 23rd to Friday June 28th, 2024 at the Mission Springs Camp and Conference Center in Scotts Valley.

Applicants who wish to apply need to comply with the Camper Eligibility Requirements, Camp Guidelines, and follow the Selection Process listed below.

Camper Eligibility Requirements

- Be a current Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior, attending a High School in Alameda, who will return to high school the fall following camp.
- Have demonstrated leadership experience and/or potential as shown by active participation in school or community groups.
- Be of high moral character.
- Be cooperative and willing to participate at RYLA as a member of a group.
- Have an open mind and desire to grow.

Camp Guidelines:

- Timely completion of camper registration.
- Abide by all camp rules as outlined in the camp registration.
- Accepted applicants must be at RYLA the entire duration of camp. They cannot show up late or leave early.
- All campers must take the buses to camp as it is an integral piece of the RYLA experience; no exceptions. Parents cannot drive them to Mission Springs due to the problems it creates for staff.
- Parents/guardians/caretakers accept responsibility for drop off and pick up of campers from the bus locations provided by Camp RYLA.
- Meeting your club's requirements for participation.
- Meeting for accepted applicants and their families. This typically occurs in late May.
- RYLA participants may also be asked to attend your Rotary Club meeting to share their experiences following Camp RYLA.

Selection Process

- Fill out the attached Rotary Club of Alameda Selection Questionnaire and submit it via email to <u>rylaalameda@gmail.com</u> by midnight (PST) on Friday April 26th, 2024
- Attend a 15 minute in-person or virtual selection interview on Saturday May 4th, 2024

 - between 5pm and 8pm
- While we encourage everyone eligible to apply, Alameda Rotary is limited to sponsoring four campers this year.
