What is Concerts at the Cove?





Now in its 17th year, Concerts at the Cove has become an institution in the City of Alameda. Each second Friday in June, July, and August, hundreds of visitors walk or bike to Crab Cove Visitors Center to enjoy a *free* family friendly concert featuring one of the bay area's best bands. The meadow area at Crab Cove with its stunning view of the San Francisco Bay is the perfect location for a summer concert.

This year, the music lineup will be spectacular. On June 9th, the Bay Area's own *Urban Outlaws* will take the stage. Their mission: To Learn Every County Song Ever Written! Except Shania Twain! Drop by and see if it is really true.

The Patsychords – Vocalist Margaret Belton channeled country western superstar Patsy Cline in two sold out runs of *Always Patsy Cline* at the Altarena Playhouse. She returns to the stage on July 14th along with her good friend "Louise" who will emcee.

The August 11th concert will showcase *The Up and Down*. The band has been part of the local Alameda music scene for years. In 2015, they were awarded the Readers Choice Best Band in Alameda Magazine.



In addition to great music, local restaurants offer soft tacos, hot dogs, kettle corn, and other tasty treats for sale, and the Rotary Club of Alameda sells beverages. Stop by the designated beverage area and enjoy a glass of wine from R & B Cellars, Rosenblum Cellars, and Rock Wall Wine Company.

There are plenty of activities for younger family members.
The Crab Cove Visitors Center stays open during the concert for families to explore the displays and learn more about the plants and animals that inhabit the area. There is a craft table for the small fries and one might even get

to pet a snake or tortoise. Alameda's own Kenny the Clown has been known to drop by and make a few balloon sculptures while local face painter extraordinaire Alana Dill will transform a little face into a tiger or fairy.

The Alameda Rotary Club has partnered with the East Bay Regional Park District and the Regional Parks Foundation to produce Concerts at the Cove to raise money for the Alameda Rotary's Community Grants Program.

Concerts at the Cove brings together Alameda Rotary Club members and East Bay Regional Park personnel working to create a family friendly evening at Crab Cove while raising money that goes back into the Alameda community through the 2017 Alameda Rotary Community Grants Program. Through the efforts of these committed folks, Concerts at the Cove raised over \$20,000 in 2015 that was distributed to local Alameda non-profit organizations. Past recipients of the grant program included social services organizations like Alameda Meals on Wheels, the Alameda Food Bank, Alameda Family Services for Head Start, and Alameda Point Collaborative. Additional grants went to youth service organizations such as the Alameda Educational Foundation, Boy Scouts, Alameda Boys and Girls Club, Alternatives in Action, and Girl's Inc. of the Island City. The Friends of the Alameda Animal Shelter and Rhythmix Cultural Works also received grants for the special role they play in contributing to the quality of life local residents enjoy.

For individuals, businesses, and organizations that believe in giving back to the community and are looking for a way to pool their contributions with others to multiply the impact their gift will have to a local Alameda non-profit organization, a sponsorship or donation to the Alameda Rotary Club Concerts at the Cove music series will achieve that result.

Stage Partner

Help defray the cost of renting the stage by having your company's 4'W x 3'H banner hung from the main stage. The stage partner sponsorship includes a table display as described above, your banner hung on the main stage, and the emcee will recognize your business and announce your location during the welcome speech and at the set break. If your company does not have a 4' x 3' banner, Rotary can recommend a local Rotarian owned business that can produce a banner for you.

In Kind Sponsorship



In order to produce the Concerts at the Cove music series, the Rotary Club of Alameda rents equipment and purchases products and supplies. By reducing these expenses, the Club cuts costs and is able to direct more money to the community grants program. If your organization has access to any of the following items or reimburses the Club for its expenditure, the available funding for the community grants program grows dollar for dollar. The cash equivalent of each item is provided in parenthesis after the item.

The Alameda Rotary Endowment Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. To the extent that the donor does not receive a benefit from the donation, the full value of the donation might be deductible to qualified individuals. Check with your tax professional before donating to be sure you qualify for the deduction.

Items needed for each one of the three concerts:

- STAGE (\$1,700) 20' W x 16' D x 3' H heavy duty stage with steps, railing, and black skirting.
- SOUND SYSTEM (\$2500) capable of delivering high quality sound in an outdoor environment.
- GENERATOR (\$500) 25KW(70a 3ph) Generator w/100' cable (specifications available on request).
- BAND (\$1,500) Contact Jeff Cambra at (510) 865-3636 for qualifications.
- BEER (\$400) Two kegs of local beer (one lighter style/one full bodied) with dispensing system.
- WINE (\$600) Total of six cases of wine, one red and one white from each of three local wineries.
- ICE (\$75) 150 lbs. of cubed ice.
- BEVERAGE SERVICE SUPPLIES (\$100)
- PRINT AD (\$200 each) Two 3 column by 5" ads in the Alameda Sun or Alameda Journal
- PRINT AD (\$500 each) One 3 column by 8" ad in the East Bay Express
