



KETTERING ROTARY CLUB MEMBERSHIP MISSION STATEMENT

- To secure a legacy for Kettering Rotary and increase our club's "circle of influence" by obtaining new members. This will keep our club vibrant and relevant in our community.

KETTERING ROTARY MEMBERSHIP TIERS

Initiation fee: None

1. Primary Rotary International Member: Full membership in the club and Rotary International. Voting at club, district, and international levels. Eligible to hold executive roles at club, district, and international levels.

Dues: \$200 annually (\$110 to Rotary International, \$50 to District 6670, and \$40 to KRC)

2. FAMILY MEMBERSHIPS

a. Secondary Rotary International Member from the same family as the Primary Member: Full membership in the club and Rotary International. Voting at club, district, and international levels. Eligible to hold executive roles at club, district, and international levels. The Primary Member sponsoring this member will receive 250 points toward a Paul Harris Fellowship.

Dues: \$175 annually (\$150 to District/International and \$25 to KRC)

b. Secondary Club Level Member: A member from the same family who is not an official Rotary International member cannot hold office or vote at district or international levels. This member cannot hold an executive role in Kettering Rotary Club, but may serve as a committee chair and has full KRC voting, participation, and fellowship opportunities.

Dues: \$100 annually (No District/International dues; all funds go directly to the club)

Membership dues may increase in accordance with Rotary International rates.

NOTES

1. The Family Membership will include at least one Primary Member at full dues.
2. Each Primary Member may nominate up to three other members of their household as additional Club Members - spouse, partner, sibling, parent, or child/offspring - age 18 or older. If the Primary Member leaves the club, one Secondary Member will become the Primary Member, with the corresponding change in dues.
3. The Membership Chair is authorized to extend additional discounts or incentives and shall report them to the Board.
4. KRC will report Rotary International Members identified in Tier 1 and Tier 2a as full members to Rotary International and the District.
5. Secondary Members may choose Rotary International or Club Level membership and will be informed of the differences. All members will be treated with dignity and respect, regardless of the level selected.
