## **Scholarship Details**

After receiving verification of the award recipient's acceptance and enrollment in an educational program for the fall of 2024, the check will be presented to the recipient at a Rotary De Soto Rotary meeting.

## **Requirements**

Applicants should be 2024 graduates from De Soto High School.

The award recipient is required to present a verbal report to the De Soto Rotary the following year, summarizing your educational experience and your progress toward attaining your goals.

The 3 part application must be received no later than April 30, 2024. You may write or type your own version of the application below. However, it needs to contain the same: (1)information, (2)answers, and (3)essay as requested on this application form.
