The De Soto Rotary recognizes the current high demand for a skilled and hands on workforce. Many of today's skilled job opportunities are in high demand and are left unfilled. For those graduates that are considering a career trade path, the De Soto Rotary offers a one-time, \$1,000 scholarship to a deserving high school senior from the Class of 2025 who plans to continue their education through a technical certification program.

The De Soto Rotary will review the scholarship applications and notify all of the applicants of our decision. We will present the selected applicant the award at the De Soto High School Senior Awards ceremony on May 14th, 2025.

After receiving verification of the award recipient's acceptance and enrollment in an educational program for the fall of 2025, the check will be presented to the recipient at a Friday morning De Soto Rotary meeting.

Requirements

Applicants should be 2025 graduates from De Soto High School.

The award recipient is required to present a verbal report to the De Soto Rotary the following year, summarizing your educational experience and your progress toward attaining your goals.

The 3 part application must be received no later than April 30, 2025. You may write or type your own version of the application below. However, it needs to contain the same: (1)information, (2)answers, and (3)essay as requested on this application form.
