Rotary Tidbits

From the earliest days of Rotary, Rotarians were concerned with promoting high ethical standards in their professional lives. One of the world's most widely printed and quoted statements of business ethics is The Four-Way Test, which was created in 1932 by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor (who later served as RI president) when he was asked to take charge of a company that was facing bankruptcy.

Our commitment to service is ongoing. Rotarians worldwide began the fight against polio in 1979 with a project to immunize 6 million children in the Philippines. By 2015, only two countries in the world remain polio-endemic—down from 125 countries in 1988.

The Olathe Rotary Club was chartered on August 17, 1937. Olathe Rotarians have given generously to community, regional, national, and international efforts. The Club is currently supporting an Deb's House orphanage in Romania, assisting with education, health care, food and clothing. This effort is spearheaded by Olathe Rotarian Elizabeth Alex. Olathe Rotarians are also supporting clean water and a variety of other initiatives in Guatemala, chaired by Past District Governor, and Olathe Rotarian, Wes McCoy.

Heart to Heart International, a worldwide relief organization, began with Olathe Rotary. The largest volunteer relief effort of its kind at that time in U.S. history, organized by Olathe Rotarians, including Dr. Gary Morsch, now Heart to Heart President, sent 75 tons of relief supplies on a C-5 Galaxy cargo plane to Moscow in 1992.
