A Message From Our 2019-2020 Olathe Rotary President, Terry Lynch



Twenty years ago I first became President of this club. In the intervening years I have been witness to many changes. Most of the changes have been good. Without question the most significant change was the admission of women as member some 30 years ago, which was absolutely essential to the survival of Rotary as we know it. Women have brought a new perspective and energy to Rotary that has only begun to be utilized in many clubs.

I believe we have been slow to engage our new members in leadership in our club. I want to change that. The future of Rotary is not with me, but with the young women and men that have chosen to join us. I also want to make leadership in our club not a burdensome

task, but one that makes Rotary come alive and satisfying. You should not have to be retired or give up your day job to be president or treasurer or serve on the board. Toward that end I have invited 4 of our newer members to serve on the Board with me. I am excited about what they will bring to our club.

We must not forget the mission of Rotary is to give "Service Above Self", not to simply raise money. It is not my plan to commit the club to a big fundraiser, but to have smaller events, and do more hands on service projects that engage more club members, like our school nurse project, tree planting, and painting the USA map on Title 1 elementary school playgrounds. I am open to input from the club for service projects and activities that will engage our club and inspire us.

We need to engage the business leaders in our community to become partners with us in serving the needs of our community. Reach out to them, invite them to join our club, and give them a platform to give service, not just money. Any project or activity that we take on as a club should consider 1) Does it bring our club together, and 2) Does it make our club stronger.

As the incoming President, I have many things I want to accomplish, but I need the help and support from the entire membership. . We invite you to raise your hand, stand up, and insist you be used. That is what gives life its purpose and satisfaction. We are far more than a lunch club and it will take all of us to make our 2019-2020 Rotary year a big success.
