Rotary recently learned that scammers have created multiple email and social media accounts that impersonate RI President Barry Rassin and General Secretary John Hewko. The social media accounts are on LinkedIn, Twitter, and WhatsApp.

Rotary members should continue to exercise caution:

- Disregard any suspicious message that offers money, requests money, or asks for your personal information.
- Avoid opening attachments or following links in suspicious messages.
- Pay close attention to the details of the email address and signature block to verify the sender.

# **Olathe Rotarians Provide Support To 57 Olathe School Nurses**



This is the fourth year Olathe Rotarians have prepared, packed, and delivered supplies for each of the 57 school nurses in the Olathe Public School District. The \$4,000 project was jointly funded by the Olathe Rotary Club and a District Rotary Grant. Daily our school nurses deal with a multitude of health concerns ranging from diabetes to colds/flu to more serious illnesses. In addition, our nurses are responsible for all standard health screenings such as vision and hearing. They are the first responders when young students get sick at school and they are the daily providers of doctor prescribed medication for our younger students. With school budgets being trimmed, often we see school nurses reaching into their own pockets. This is why we began, and support, this great program.

Nurses in the Olathe School District who received "Care Packages" included 5 High Schools, 10 Middle Schools, 35 Elementary Schools, 2 pre-schools, 2 alternative schools, St. Pauls and Prince of Peace Catholic Schools, and Heritage Christian Academy. Nurses received things like anti-bacterial hand gel, granola bars, chapstick, cough drops, wipes, etc. Elementary School "Care Packages" also included a supply of new underwear and socks.

We thank Cindy VonFeldt, Executive Director of the Olathe Public Schools Foundation and Olathe Rotarian, Pat O'Donnell, Olathe Rotary President, and Jason Armstrong for organizing this project and securing a matching grant. We appreciate all Rotarians who prepared, packed, and delivered the "Care Packages" to each school nurse.
