- Applications will be judged by club members.
- Family members of Rotarians are ineligible.
- Winners will be guests at the club's regular Friday breakfast meeting May 3, 2019 at 7:00 a.m. at Town Hall, Shawnee Town 1929, 11600 Johnson Dr., Shawnee, Kansas. At that time, winners will tell the club about themselves, their community service, and their college plans.

Applications must be postmarked or hand-delivered no later than Monday, April 1, 2019

- Scholarships need not be used in the 2019-2020 school year.
- Scholarships may be used at the post-secondary school of the student's choice.
- Each scholarship will be paid directly to the post-secondary school after the student has enrolled.
