More than 1.2 million men and women in over 200 countries and geographical areas belong to over 33,000 Rotary clubs.

Members join Rotary for many different reasons - community involvement, personal development, professional networking, friendship – but the most important benefit is the satisfaction gained from making a real difference in the world.

- Access to Rotary International and Downtown Topeka Rotary online networking resources which enable you to connect with other Rotarians to share ideas and plan and execute projects.
- You are welcome to attend the regular weekly meetings at noon on Thursdays and pay only for the meals when you attend. You can pay at the reception desk when you arrive at the meeting. The weekly meeting reminders will be emailed to you to keep you posted on club meetings and activities.
- You are encouraged to participate in club projects, activities, club socials annually. These will be listed in the weekly meeting reminder and through special emails.
- You are encouraged to attend a New Member Orientation to learn more about Rotary and your club, but this is not required.
- You may at any time change your membership status and dues payments to that of a regular Rotary member (\$202 quarterly, including all meals).

## **VENTURE DUES SCHEDULE**

Dues are paid on a quarterly basis and are billed in the months of **July, October, January, and April**. The dues for Venture Members are \$50 each quarter, which covers The Rotarian Magazine; Club, District, and Rotary International Dues. You are welcome and encouraged to attend the Thursday Noon luncheon as often as you can. When you do attend, you pay \$13 for your meal at the reception desk. There are no meal charges for meetings that you cannot attend.

The dues for a new member are prorated according to the month in which you join. The Board of Directors approve nominees for membership on the second week of each month and new members are not charged for dues or meals the month in which they are accepted.
