Payment Categories

Rotary Club of Topeka has two payment categories. The options are to pay only the dues each quarter or to pay the dues as well as prepay meals each quarter. Dues only is \$60 per quarter and dues with prepaid meals is \$207 per quarter. Meals at meetings that aren't prepaid are \$15 payable at the door.

Dues Schedule

Dues are paid quarterly and are billed in the months of June, September, December, and March. The dues are \$60 each quarter (depending upon which membership category you choose), which covers The Rotarian Magazine; Club, District and Rotary International Dues. The dues for a new member are prorated according to the month in which you join. The Board of Directors approves nominees for membership monthly.

Attendance Expectations

Most people find regular attendance to meetings helps them get the most out of Rotary. Rotary Club of Topeka does not have an official attendance policy, but we hope to see you at as many meetings as possible. Our meetings are held at noon on Thursdays in the Kay McFarland venue at the Topeka Zoo. Check topekarotary.org for weekly meeting details. You will also receive weekly email meeting reminders that will give you information about the meeting.
