“A Starry Night” (formerly Cabaret) is our annual charity dinner auction held in the fall. This event has raised over \$2 Million. These funds have been used to support local and international charitable organizations and projects since 1987. Our club is particularly interested in projects that combine sweat-equity (from Rotarians) with cash, or a specific program that needs funding.

If you have a project or organization that is in need of financial or physical support, we ask that you apply right away. Fulfilling your request will be based on a number of criteria including the following:

1. Does the project or organization stand for the same ideals and goals as Rotary International?
2. Can your organization help assist our club with promoting and supporting “A Starry Night”, our annual charity fundraiser?
3. Will the project or organization help promote the ideals of Rotary?

100% of the Net Proceeds from this yearly event are giving to the Pleasanton North Rotary Foundation which is a 501(c)(3) entity.

Applications for Grants are reviewed only 3 times per year and are evaluated on a first come, first served basis. Applications must be submitted by 1/12, 5/9 and 11/10.
