There will be drawings for door prizes throughout the day.

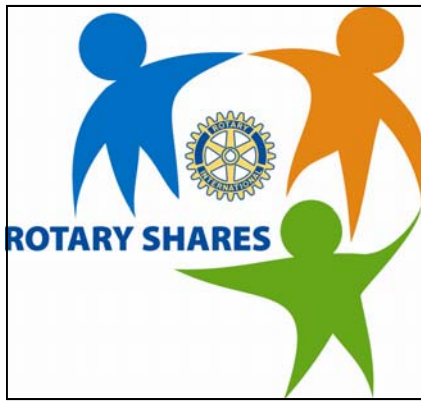

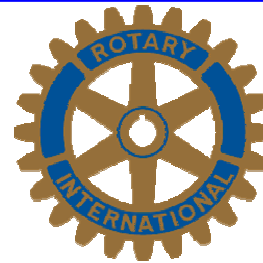
