Since Robert loved to travel, donors will use "globe" squeeze balls which they will get to keep. They will also get t-shirts and 2008 Carter BloodCare calendars.

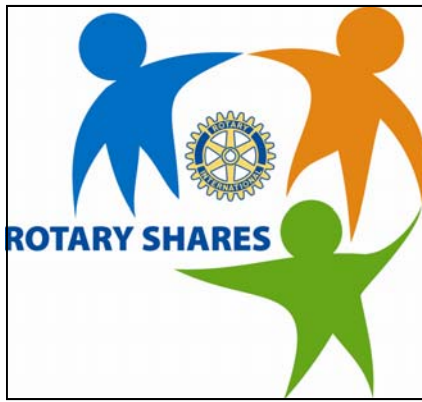
There will be drawings for door prizes throughout the day.

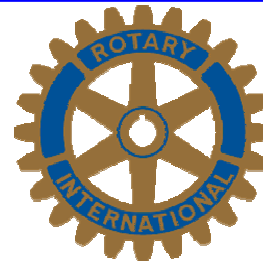
