2. You will help the Sergeant-at-arms set up for a meeting. You will set up all banners and Flag, and place Gold cups on the tables. After the meeting you will put everything back.
3. Register on clubs web site as well as the District and Rotary international and update your profile. You must update your special interest and join a chat group.
4. Help on a service project, list of service opportunities attached.
5. You will meet with club contact Gary Short (817)283-4288 [gary.short@edwardjones.com](mailto:gary.short@edwardjones.com), to learn about Paul Harris. They will help you learn how to achieve and help set up a time line of expectations on when to achieve.
6. You will sit on a Board meeting to learn the directives of the club.
7. You will join a committee and help with the direction of said committee.
