

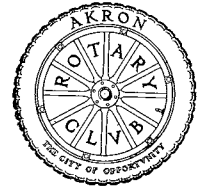

## Constitution

### ARTICLE I.

The name of this organization shall be the AKRON ROTARY CLUB.

### ARTICLE II

Its Objects Are:

To promote the recognition of the worthiness of all legitimate occupations, and to dignify each member's occupation as affording him an opportunity to serve society.

To encourage high ethical standards in business and professions.

To increase the efficiency of each member by the exchange of ideas and business methods.

To promote the scientizing of acquaintance as an opportunity for service and an aid to success.

To quicken the interest of each member in the public welfare and to co-operate with others in civic development.

### ARTICLE III.

#### MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS.

SECTION 1. Any adult male person of good moral character, who is engaged as proprietor, partner, corporate officer, agent or manager in full charge in any legitimate business or professional undertaking, in the County of Summit, State of Ohio, shall be eligible to membership unless engaged in an occupation already represented by a member. His classification as a member shall be that of his principal and recognized occupation. Membership is that of the individual and not of his firm or corporation.

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### ARTICLE V

#### DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Club and of the Board of Directors, and to perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to the office.

#### VICE-PRESIDENT.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the Vice-President in the absence of the President to preside at all meetings of the Club, and to perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to the office.

#### SECRETARY.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep a record of business transacted, send out notices of meetings and perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to the office or are provided for herein. It shall also be the duty of the Secretary to keep record of the membership and attendance.

#### TREASURER.

SECTION 4. It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to hold custody of all funds, accounting for same to this Club at its monthly and annual meetings and at any other time upon demand by the Board of Directors; and on his retirement from office to turn over to his successor or to the President all funds in his possession, and to perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to the office or are provided for herein.

#### SERGEANT-AT-ARMS.

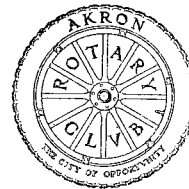
SECTION 5. The Sergeant-at-Arms shall preserve order at all meetings and perform such other duties as ordinarily pertain to this office.

occupation under which he was elected to membership and thereby duplicates the classification of some other member.

SECTION 6. Election to membership shall be in the following manner: A person shall be considered for membership only when proposed by two members. The proposal shall be on the Club's regular application blank and shall contain the name, address, proposed business or professional classification and a statement of the qualifications of the person for membership, etc. The Secretary will submit such proposal to Board of Directors, to reasonably fill classification, and then pass on to the Membership Committee. If the Membership Committee, by a majority vote, recommend the acceptance of said proposal, such fact shall be certified to the Secretary, who will submit it back to the Board of Directors, and if approved by a majority of the Board, the Secretary shall then cause a notice to be mailed out to each member at least ten days prior to the date of meeting at which the Club shall vote on such name. Written protests to the President against the admission of any candidate on the ground of conflict in business or professional representation may be made within one week after date of notice, and any such protest shall be forthwith decided by the Board of Directors. If the Board decides that a conflict exists, the proposed shall be deemed rejected, and the name of the proposed placed on the waiting list. If no such protest is filed, a vote may be taken on the question of the admission to membership of such person.

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SECTION 2. It is understood that any person accepting active partnership or associate membership thereby signifies his desire to be recorded as a subscriber to the official magazine publication of the International Association of Rotary Clubs in full accordance with the by-laws of this club.

SECTION 3. Partners of members, officers of corporations already represented not to exceed two in number of any member or represented corporation, who occupy positions involving the use of discretionary power, shall on motion of such member or corporate representative, become eligible to membership; provided, however, that membership under this section shall not endure longer than the connection of such member with his proposer or represented corporation, nor longer than the membership of such proposer.

SECTION 4. Honorary Members may be elected at any regular meeting, a quorum being present, by the unanimous vote of the members in attendance, providing a proposal for such membership shall have been made at a previous regular meeting. Non-residents of Summit County, retired business or professional men, and representatives of corporations or associations not for pecuniary gain, shall be eligible to honorary membership. Honorary members shall have the privilege of attending meetings and participating in the social functions of the club. They shall not be required to pay dues.

SECTION 5. Membership shall endure for life (unless forfeited or resigned as herein provided), or until the member abandons the particular

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#### BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

SECTION 6. The Board of Directors, consisting of eleven members of the Club, three of whom shall be the President, Vice-President, and Secretary, respectively, shall constitute the governing body of this Club, and their decision on all matters shall be final, subject only to appeal to the Club. It shall have general control over all officers and committees and may for good cause declare any office or offices vacant. It shall constitute a Board of Appeals from the rulings of all officers and actions of all committees. Appeal may be taken from any decision of the Board of Directors to the Club, and such appeal shall be determined by majority vote at any regular meeting.

SECTION 7. All officers and directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Club to be held on the second Monday in February of each year. Four directors shall be elected at each annual meeting to serve two years. In the event of any office becoming vacant, it shall be filled temporarily by the Board of Directors and permanently at the next regular meeting of the Club.

#### ARTICLE VI

##### AMENDMENTS.

This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting, a quorum being present, by a two-third vote of all members present, provided that notice of such proposed amendment shall have been mailed to each member at least ten (10) days before such meeting.

son at any regular meeting. The candidate shall be elected a member, subject to payment of dues, providing there shall not be five or more dissenting votes cast by those members present, such dissenting constituting a rejection of the name by the Club.

SECTION 7. The resignation of any member shall become effective immediately upon its delivery to the President or Secretary, providing all indebtedness of such member to the Club has been paid.

SECTION 8. Any member who refuses or neglects to pay any indebtedness due to the Club within ten days after demand has been made by registered letter, shall thereby forfeit his membership.

SECTION 9. If any member shall absent himself from four successive meetings of the Club without good cause, and if in the judgment of the Board of Directors said member is not active and interested in the objects and work of the Club, the Board of Directors, may, with or without notice, terminate his membership.

SECTION 10. Any member whose connection with this Club shall be severed by resignation, death, expulsion or otherwise, shall forfeit all interest in any property belonging to the Club.

#### ARTICLE IV

##### OFFICERS.

The officers of this Club shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergeant-at-Arms, and Board of Directors.

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## ARTICLE VII

### ENTERTAINMENT COMMITTEE.

The Entertainment Committee shall prepare and arrange programs for the regular meetings; they shall prepare and arrange such social functions as may be directed by the Board of Directors or the Club; also devise and put into execution plans for the entertainment of the members at the meetings.

## ARTICLE VIII

### FRATERNAL COMMITTEE.

The Fraternal Committee shall promote friendship and acquaintance among the members; each member of the Committee shall be assigned his pro-rata of the membership of the Club for personal work among them in extending and bettering their acquaintance among Club members, and do such other work in pursuance of the general objects of the Committee as may be assigned by the President, Board of Directors or the Club.

## ARTICLE IX

### WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE.

The Ways and Means Committee shall be of such number as the President shall from time to time deem advisable. Its duty shall be to devise and put into execution plans tending to effectuate the general purposes of the Club and to raise money therefor. The Treasurer and all Past Presidents shall be ex-officio members.

## ARTICLE X

### PUBLIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE.

The Committee on Public Affairs shall report from time to time upon

## By-Laws

### ARTICLE I

#### MEETINGS.

SECTION 1. Regular meetings of the Akron Rotary Club shall be held on the second and fourth Mondays of each month, except the months of July and August, or as otherwise directed by the Board of Directors.

SECTION 2. Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be called by the President whenever he deems it necessary or whenever requested by two (2) members of the Board. At least twenty-four (24) hours' notice shall be given by the Secretary to members of the Board of all its meetings.

### ARTICLE II

#### QUORUM.

One-fourth of the members in good and regular standing shall constitute a quorum at meetings of this Club.

### ARTICLE III

#### MEMBERSHIP FEE AND DUES.

There shall be a membership fee of \$10.00 (ten dollars) required of all members on admission to this Club, in addition to the annual dues. The membership dues shall be \$20.00 (twenty dollars) per annum (to include the cost of the monthly dinners) for the purpose of meeting the current expenses of the Club, and shall be payable March first in advance, and any extra assessments may be authorized by the Board of Directors.

### ARTICLE IV

#### METHOD OF VOTING.

All business of this organization shall be transacted by viva voce

the general subject to which the proposed resolution relates shall have first been considered by a Committee and a report made to the Club by such Committee; provided, however, that in case of an emergency, the resolution may be considered, providing the above rule is suspended by a unanimous vote.

### ARTICLE XIV

#### FINANCES.

SECTION 1. The Treasurer shall deposit all funds of the Club in some bank to be named by the Directors.

SECTION 2. Bills shall be paid only by checks signed by the Treasurer upon vouchers signed by any two officers. An audit shall be made once a year.

SECTION 3. The Secretary and the Treasurer shall give such bond as may be required by the Board of Directors for the safe custody of the funds of the Club and for the performance of the fiduciary duties of their office.

### ARTICLE XV

#### OFFICIAL PUBLICATION.

SECTION 1. Each member shall sign a yearly subscription for the Official Magazine Publication of the International Association of Rotary Clubs. The subscription shall be collected by the Club from its members as part of the regular dues. The Secretary shall enter such subscription on his books in a special subscription account and shall forward the same to the business office of said publication as a Club subscription.

#### ARTICLE XI

##### GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE.

The Grievance Committee shall receive, consider and pass upon complaints of members against the Club and upon charges of any member against another member of the violation of the principles of Rotary.

When requested by the members involved it may try and adjudicate personal differences and property disputes.

#### ARTICLE XII

##### NOMINATING COMMITTEE.

The Nominating Committee shall consist of five members, to be appointed not later than thirty (30) days previous to the annual meeting. This Committee shall report at the meeting next preceding the annual meeting nominations for officers and directors of the Club.

#### ARTICLE XIII

##### POLITICS BARRED.

SECTION 1. This Club shall at no time endorse or recommend any candidate for public office, nor shall political candidates or partisan questions as such be discussed at any Club meeting.

SECTION 2. No resolution which would have the effect of placing the Club on record in favor of or against any pending legislation or proposed or suggested governmental action or containing an endorsement or recommendation on any matter of civic importance may be voted upon until

#### ARTICLE V

##### COMMITTEES.

The President shall appoint the following committees:

- Membership.
- Entertainment.
- Fraternal.
- Ways and Means.
- Public Affairs.
- Grievance.
- Nominating.

The President and Secretary shall be ex-officio members of all committees. All committees shall consist of at least three members exclusive of President and Secretary. Each committee shall transact such business as is delegated to it in the Constitution and By-Laws and such additional business as may be referred to it by the President of the Club and the Board of Directors. Except where a special authorization is given by vote of the Club or the Board of Directors, such committee shall not take final action until a report has been made and approved.

#### ARTICLE VI

##### MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE.

The Membership Committee shall investigate the character, business, social standing and eligibility of persons proposed for membership; shall accept or reject such proposals or may place the name under consideration upon a waiting list. After each meeting of the Committee the result of their proceedings shall be certified to the Secretary.
