

The 2015-16 Rotary dues are as follows: \$275 (includes dues; Urbana Rotary Charities contribution; and Rotary International Foundation contribution).

Weekly lunch costs are \$12 per meal for a full meal or \$9 for the salad paid by each member. In addition, the annual costs of social events and other events may range from nominal to several hundred dollars per year, depending on participation.

Members are also encouraged to become "Paul Harris Sustaining Members" by contributing \$100 each year to support the Rotary Foundation's programs such as Polio Plus (eradicating Polio worldwide), Matching Grant Humanitarian Grants, and Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarships (for International Studies).
