Call to Order/Declaration of Quorum

Approval of Agenda

Approval of Minutes

Treasurer's Report

Carmen presented the treasurer's report. Current Assets total \$23,351.82 with a YTD income of \$11,088.62 on expenses of \$11,959.14 for a net loss of \$871.57.

Political Topics for Club Programs

The Board discussed if Political Candidates should be speakers at our weekly lunch meetings. Bethany thinks that a good compromise to the situation is if our club hosts a meet and great with political candidates as an event during election years. This would prevent all campaigning during lunch meetings but still give members a

chance to have a personal exchange with candidates if they are interested. As a general practice speakers will be asked not to campaign during our lunch meetings, but they are free to come talk about other topics. Ashley will follow up with Cathy Cline updating her on what the Board discussed.

Annual Membership Meeting Discussion

The Board discussed that we need to schedule our Annual Membership Meeting – preferable sooner than later. Need to inform the club of the meeting at least a month prior. We also need to solicit nominations for the new Board of Directors. The Board set a meeting date of February 8th and the meeting will be announced in January. An email will also be sent out beginning of January informing the club and soliciting nominations.

The Board discussed that the District Conference will be in Lander this year. We should have a presence at the conference. The club will typically pay for registration fees. Announce to the general membership that the conference will be local and see who is interested in attending at a later date.
