“16 year-old female refugee from Somalia experienced extensive trauma relating to both the war and domestic violence. She has been experiencing frequent headaches and blurred vision in the classroom and requires multifocal glasses which the family can’t afford.”

“34-year-old female and 59-year-old male clients with a history of homelessness and significant mental illness, have also just been moved into transitional housing. Each of them has very few belongings.”

“Our support of \$300 was spent collectively on client’s TV and furniture, swimming passes and art supplies. This has improved the comfort of these clients in transitional housing. It has also provided the opportunity to engage in activities they otherwise couldn’t afford”
