## Our Projects

We are actively involved in supporting projects on the community, national and international levels. Here is a selection:

### Special Projects:

- **International Women's Day Breakfast**, where over 1200 guests attend a breakfast to create awareness and systemic change around diversity
- **Second Hand Book Store**, through which we recycle books and raise money to support local organisations and projects
- **Annual Golf Days and Footy Breakfasts**, raising money for local projects and charities

### Local Community Projects:

- **St Silas Church**, serving at Sunday Suppers
- **South Port Day Links (SPDL)**, providing support services to the local community
- **Inner South Community Health**, providing local health services
- **Bubup Children's Centre**, assisting children's reading skills
- **Hospitality Education and Training (HEAT)**, giving disengaged youth a pathway to meaningful employment through the St Kilda Youth Services
- **Albert Park College**, providing scholarships supporting their literacy programme, and working to engage students in community work
- **Local Primary Schools**, assisting students with scholarships

### International Projects:

- **International Exchange Student** sponsorship
- **Fire Emergency Vehicle in South Africa**, assistance in purchase
- **Sanitation Project - Palghar, India**, providing water systems, toilet blocks and sanitary napkin machinery
- **Dignity for Young Women in Uganda**, support for health projects
- **Mainit Primary School in Philippines**, renovation of classrooms
- **Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children (ROMAC)**, bringing children to Australia for life changing surgery
- **Tibetan Village Project Australia (TVPA)** support for their works
- **Cambodian Kids Foundation (CKF)** support for their works
