The BE THE HERO is a violence prevention program designed for and targeted at young men? A Victorian Women's Trust initiative supported by the Rotary Club of Albert Park, the program is being rolled out to teenagers in schools all over Victoria Supporters believe that if the program changes the life of one young man by influencing him not to follow his father's violent role modelling, then it has achieved its objective.

The Program Aims to:


- Provide a greater understanding of the extent of violence against women.
- Help identify ways young men can safely be involved in taking a stand against violence against women.




