Awards for Excellence - Albert Park, Middle Park & Port Melbourne Primary Schools	
<p>We make a number of <i>Award for Excellence</i> presentations to Year 6 graduating students. recipients are selected by their teachers on the basis that they have engaged constructively in school learning and other activities; and that they will be commencing Year 7 at a government secondary school the following year. The award is to assist in meeting some of the expenses associated with commencing secondary school. We provide \$1200 to each of the schools - the schools give either 3 awards of \$400 or 4 awards of \$300.</p>	\$3,600
Inspire Award - Albert Park College	
<p>This award is presented to a Year 12 student at the APC Graduation ceremony. It is given to a student who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment to, and care for, others in the local or global community.</p>	\$250
