- Name and how long in Bristol Rotary (or Rotary, if elsewhere)
- Where you grew up -state, town, how long
- Where you went to school, what you did there- sports/clubs' activities
- Short recap of work history up to now, major part of work history
- If retired, current activities
- Where you live and Family, spouses, children, grandchildren
- What are your skill sets, not just on the job, but what else can you do, and what do you like to do. Highlights.
- Why did you join Rotary and what would you like to do as a Rotarian
