The Missouri RYLA Academy is a 4-day, 3-night leadership academy for diverse incoming high school sophomores and juniors who exhibit a desire for community service. Developed by some of Missouri's top professional educators and Rotarians from Districts 6040, 6060, and 6080, the curriculum is designed to identify and enhance the qualities of servant leadership for each participant, educate them on how to successfully implement a service project, and inspire them to live a lifetime of "Service Above Self." In addition, participants are introduced to the programs and values Rotary has to offer. Established in 1992, Missouri RYLA Academy has educated and inspired more than 2,000 students statewide. It is currently recognized as a model program for Rotary International, worldwide.

The two Rotary Clubs in Kirksville, Missouri (Kirksville Rotary Club, and Rotary Club of Kirksville – Thousand Hills) will sponsor 4 applicants to attend the Missouri RYLA Academy. Applicants should demonstrate a heart for service and a passion for servant leadership. Missouri RYLA Academy has set the dates for TWO Academies in 2024. Session 1: June 23 - 26, and Session 2: July 7 – July 10. Students will be allowed to choose one academy or the other on a first come basis. The academy will begin early Sunday evening and check out will be after 4pm on Wednesday night at University of Central Missouri in Warrensburg, Missouri. The academy curriculum consists of various fun activities designed to develop youth into servant leaders.
